Heart Care Programme	The Heart Care Programme is a healthcare programme including specialist case management, remote health monitoring and oversight of treatment interventions, delivered by our partner provider, Care-Connect. This programme may be suitable for members who have been diagnosed with Heart Failure and where their condition is stable. Members on the programme will be provided with a blood pressure cuff and weighing scales, shown how to take their measurements and will be required to input these into the Care-Connect app twice a week. Members can expect: Tele-consultations with a nurse and ongoing clinical support Clinical review and monitoring to ensure measurements are within the normal range Check up calls if measurements change Medication review to bring measurements back within normal range if needed Reassurance and support with any concerns regarding the condition Updates to member's GP if medication reviews or face to face visits are required	Over 18 years of age GP diagnosis of Heart Failure for longer than 3 months Condition and medication must be stable Members must have good balance and ability to weigh themselves Members must have approval from their GP or Consultant to participate in the programme	Pre-authorisation - members can register their interest in this programme through MyClinic in their member portal or by registering their details at https://care-connect.ie/#register
Respiratory Care Programme	The Respiratory Care Programme is a healthcare programme including specialist case management, remote health monitoring and oversight of treatment interventions, delivered by our partner provider, Care-Connect. This programme is suitable for members who have been diagnosed with Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD), Chronic Bronchitis, Emphysema or Bronchiectasis. Members on the programme will be provided with equipment required to take their measurements and will be shown how to take their measurements and will be required to input these into the Care-Connect app in line with their presenting symptoms. Members can expect: Tele-consultations with a nurse and ongoing clinical support Clinical review and monitoring to ensure measurements are within the normal range Medication review to bring measurements back within normal range if needed Reassurance and support with any concerns regarding the condition Updates to member's GP if medication reviews or face to face visits are required	Over 18 years of age GP diagnosis of Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD), Chronic Bronchitis, Emphysema or Bronchiectasis. Sleep Apnoea Screening Programme	The Sleep Apnoea Screening Programme has been designed for anyone who is awaiting a test for suspected sleep apnoea and is delivered by our partner provider Care-Connect. When you join the Sleep Apnoea Screening Programme, the Care-Connect team will support and guide you to complete your sleep study at home. To complete the study, you will receive a WatchPAT® device. The WatchPAT® is worn like a watch on your wrist with a finger probe and a small sensor you stick to your chest. The Care-Connect team will help you to set up the device and you'll only have to wear the WatchPAT® for one night. It will detect subtle changes in normal sleeping patterns which could indicate that you may have sleep apnoea. Once complete, Care-Connect's team/consultant will review your nighttime data and will advise you of the results. The Care-Connect team will let you and your GP know what the next best steps are, should you require treatment.	Over 18 years of age You must be currently awaiting a diagnostic sleep study for Sleep Apnoea You must discuss with your GP that you wish to avail of this service and request a referral letter to the programme. This is to ensure that your GP is happy to review your results following the sleep study and initiate treatment if required.
